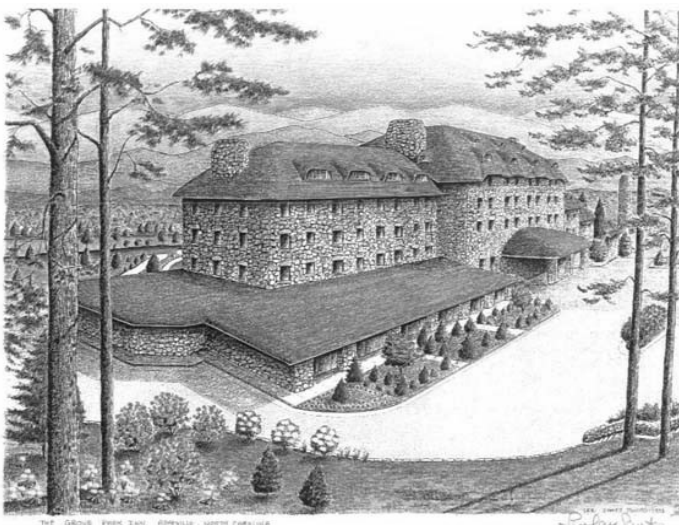
At the Grove Park Inn

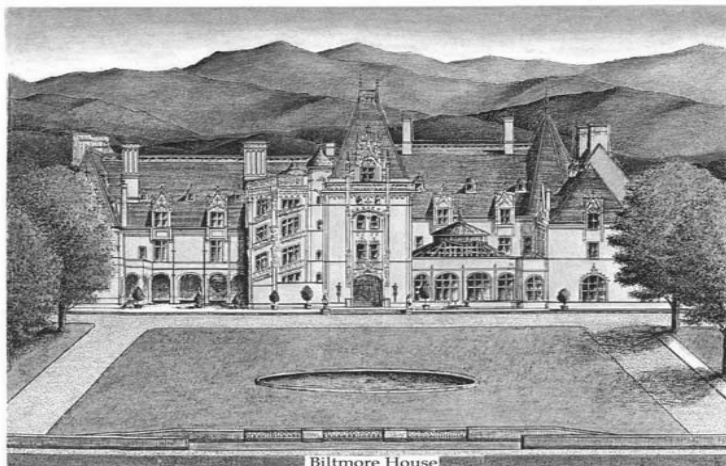
